ROME PRIZE APPLICATION GUIDELINES

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*Annual deadline for all Rome Prize applicants: November 15th*

*Below is a list of Rome Prize fellowships to be awarded in 2001–2002, including the stipend amount and length of the fellowship. Please note that in listing these fellowships, the Academy does not guarantee that every fellowship will be offered. Prior to awarding the fellowships, adjustments may be made to the stipend offered or to the length of the fellowship, based on the funding available. The Academy may make adjustments to the stipend awarded if substantial additional resources are made available.*

· *School of Fine Arts* ·

*The 1-year fellowships begin in mid-September and end in mid-August, and the 6-month fellowships generally begin in mid-September and end in mid-March.*

Two 1-year fellowships in Architecture, with stipends of up to \$20,000

Two 6-month fellowships in Design Arts, with stipends of up to \$10,000

Two 6-month fellowships in Historic Preservation and Conservation, with stipends of up to \$10,000

Two 1-year fellowships in Landscape Architecture, with stipends of up to \$20,000

Two 1-year fellowships in Literature, with stipends of up to \$20,000  
(awarded only by nomination through the American Academy of Arts and Letters)

Two 1-year fellowships in Musical Composition, with stipends of up to \$20,000

Four 1-year fellowships in Visual Arts, with stipends of up to \$20,000

*The pre-doctoral fellowships begin in mid-September and end in mid-August, the Andrew W. Mellon post-doctoral fellowships begin in mid-September and end in mid-July, and the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) post-doctoral fellowships begin in mid-September and end at the end of May.*

Two 1-year pre-doctoral fellowships in Classical Studies and Archaeology, with stipends of up to \$15,000

One 2-year pre-doctoral fellowship in Classical Studies and Archaeology, with stipend of up to \$15,000 per year

Two post-doctoral fellowships (one Mellon and one NEH) in Classical Studies and Archaeology, with stipends of up to \$20,000

One 2-year pre-doctoral fellowship in History of Art, with stipend of up to \$15,000 per year

Two post-doctoral fellowships (one Mellon and one NEH) in History of Art, with stipends of up to \$20,000

Two 1-year pre-doctoral fellowships in Post-Classical Humanistic/Modern Italian Studies, with stipends of up to \$15,000

Two post-doctoral fellowships (one Mellon and one NEH) in Post-Classical Humanistic/Modern Italian Studies, with stipends of up to \$20,000
