Rome Prize winners are the core of the Academy's residential community, which also includes Residents, Affiliated Artists and Scholars, and Visiting Artists and Scholars. Winners are invited to participate in the Rome Sustainable Food Project, which provides meals.

*The deadline for the nationwide Rome Prize competition is November 1, 2024. Applications will also be accepted between November 2 and 15 for an additional fee. No applications will be accepted after November 15.
